

# **Green Party of Colorado State Meeting & Nominating Convention Florence, Colorado – May 1, 2010 – Official Minutes**

## **2010 GREEN PARTY OF COLORADO NOMINATING CONVENTION**

Greens Present: There are now 17 registered Green Party members present, with Gary Anderson, Jerry Morgan, Daniel Sage, and Kirk Young having left. Per our decision at the state meeting to amend the bylaws to allow all registered Greens at a convention to vote at that convention, all 17 can cast votes for candidates.

### **Nomination of Candidates**

**For United States Representative, 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District – Gary Swing.** No other nominations. Gary gave a speech on why he is running for Congress, answered questions from greens, and received thunderous applause. A ballot was taken, and Gary Swing received 17 votes, or 100% of the vote. He accepted the nomination.

**For United States Senate – Bob Kinsey.** No other nominations. Bob gave a speech on why he is running for Senate, answered questions from greens, and received thunderous applause. A ballot was taken, and Bob Kinsey received 17 votes, or 100% of the vote. He accepted the nomination.

The proper forms for certification of both candidates were prepared by the Secretary and Chair of the Convention, and were duly forwarded to the Secretary of State per state law.

A few announcements were made, including suggestions for fundraising and sale of merchandise by Kevin Alumbaugh, as well as his suggestion we divide up the list of registered greens in Colorado to call them by phone to get them active in our campaigns and activities, but due to the late hour these suggestions were not acted upon.

Co-chair Tanya Ishikawa declared the convention adjourned.
